SSQ: Information and Assistance

1. DEW's Invitation to Bid/Prequalification and/or other solicitations referenced the SSQ requirement and noted that Subcontractors shall provide their EMR and OSHA /VOSHA Compliance Record for review and prior to subcontracting to DEW.
2. EMR: This is your Workers Compensation experience rating. It is a numerical rating provided annually to you by NCCI. If you do not know your numerical rating, you can find it on your workers compensation policy. You can also call your insurance agent for the rating.
3. OSHA/VOSHA Compliance Record for the most recent five-year period: This is your record of Safety/Health violations, if any, and is available on the OSHA website. To access your record;
 - A. Log on to www.osha.gov.
 - B. Click "Data and Statistics" bar
 - C. Click "Establishment Search" under the Inspection Data header.
 - D. Enter your exact Company Name and go directly to the "Submit" button.
 - E. If a Record is available, click "Select All", then click "Get Detail".
 - F. Print the Record and submit it with the SSQ.
